SENIOR SPEAKERS

CHARACTERISTICS OF AN EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATOR

1. **Sincerity:** Senior speakers should mean what they say and say what they mean. In other words, they must themselves believe in what they are saying. Credibility is for certain the number one priority of any effective communicator.
2. **Knowledge:** Senior speakers must speak knowledgeably. It must be evident research and preparation went into their speech. Speakers should demonstrate a quiet confidence in the knowledge of their material if they are to demand the respect and the attention of the audience.
3. **Organization:** Senior speakers must have a very distinct beginning, middle and end to their presentation. A clear message begins with a definite purpose and proceeds in a single direction to the end. They must exhibit the ability to share their ideas, their thoughts, and their opinions in a well-organized manner keeping their audience in mind at all times.
4. **Nonverbal Communication:** Senior speakers must possess the ability to utilize their verbal and non- verbal communication skills to send a congruent communication to the audience. Tone, vocal inflection, gestures, kinesics (body movement) eye contact, and other artifacts (i.e. dress, jewelry) prove key in providing an audience with a believable message.
5. **Language:** Good speakers choose their words carefully and strategically for maximum effect. They must utilize language to create the effect they desire from their audience.
6. **Goal Setting:** Senior speakers must know exactly what impact they want to make upon their audience. They must have excellent insight as to the audience make-up and “play” to that particular audience in order to achieve their goal.
7. **Content:** Senior speakers must share an original, worthwhile message proving appropriate to the situation.
8. **Delivery:** Senior speakers must enthusiastically deliver their message with confidence. Again, confidence is key in any speaking situation.
