I/We, _____, the parent(s) or guardian(s) of, _____, do understand and agree with the following guidelines regarding FHE Region III graduation. I/We do understand these requirements must be met in order to participate in this graduation ceremony and that I will not be an official member of the FHE Region 3 Senior Class until the full payment is received and this registration is processed by the dates noted below.

1. Families must be members of Families for Home Education (FHE) and have homeschooled at least one year in addition to the senior year.
2. Although this FHE graduation ceremony is open to all FHE members, the majority of the participants hold a Christian worldview. Therefore, Christian attitudes and beliefs will be reflected in this ceremony.
3. It is highly recommended that the senior and/or the parent attend all class meetings. The April 5, 2018 meeting and May 14, 2018 graduation rehearsal are mandatory for the senior and at least one parent. Failure to attend either of these meetings will rescind this participation commitment and nullify your right to graduate with FHE.
4. Fees are \$200. Receive a \$15 early bird discount if fees are paid by October 12, 2017. All fees are due December 31, 2017. There will be a \$50 late fee for any payments received after Dec. 31, 2017. No applications will be accepted after January 15, 2018. Returned checks will incur a \$35 charge. Make checks payable to *HEART Senior Class*.
5. All deadlines must be met in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. These deadlines include paying fees, submitting photos and biographies, and submitting various order forms.
6. The senior class website is the primary form of communication for the 2018 senior class. The website is **<http://www.fheseniorclass.com>**. The website will be updated with pertinent information, including a calendar of events, sign-ups, and downloadable forms. Monthly meetings are highly recommended as they will cover many topics relevant to the graduating class. Facebook is updated with documents under the File tab. Families must submit current phone and email addresses to the senior class. Each family must check the website and read class emails. Families without internet access in the home are not excluded from this responsibility. They must obtain information from another participating family or access the website at their local library.
7. The FHE diploma is a courtesy and is issued by the parent(s.) Possession of the certificate does not verify the student's work; that is solely the responsibility of the parent(s.) The diploma is not accredited.
8. Due to contractual agreements with vendors and facilities, no refunds will be issued after December 31, 2017.
9. **Photo Release:** I agree for the graduate to be photographed in participation with FHE Region 3 Senior Class activities held throughout the year which includes but not limited to meetings, dances, social events, committees, rehearsal, and graduation. I also release and authorize the use of any photograph for placement in the yearbook, on the website or any advertising or promotional materials or publications associated with the FHE Senior Class and understand there is no compensation for said use. I understand that family members may be included in photographs if they are attending an event sponsored by the FHE Region 3 Senior Class and grant permission for use of those photographs for publication understanding there is no compensation for said use.
