Guys Dress Code: Black dress pants or slacks, shirt with a collar, ties are welcomed but not required, dark dress shoes, black socks. No flip flops or tennis shoes.

Girls Dress Code: Dress or skirt preferred, if dress is longer than graduation gown must be black. Black dress slacks, dressy shoes or sandals (remember you will be walking a number of steps, to and from the choir loft) No flip flops or tennis shoes.

Parents/Guests: Please be respectful of the church and the occasion we are celebrating when choosing your attire. As of February 18th, it looks like we can do 10 or 11 guests per graduate. Will keep you posted.

Graduation Caps: Tassel begins on the right and will be moved to the left at the end of the ceremony. For pictures – move your tassel to the left as you have “already” graduated.

Cap Decorations: Must be tasteful and appropriate, flat decorations, nothing standing up/3D, nothing hanging over the edges, must be approved at April meeting or by message before April meeting. If you are not on the approval list, you will not be allowed to wear a decorated cap. We will not have extra caps for you!!
